Well-Child Program

+++++++++++++++++++++++++

One of the most important contributions to the welfare of the people of Newport, both present and future, is the aggressive campaign conducted constantly to educate parents and provide adequate medical and dental care to all pre-school children, regardless of the parents' financial status. This service is rendered through the well-child conference which meets monthly. The doctors, dentists, health nurses and sponsoring and cooperating organizations give freely of their time to the conferences. The Service League of Newport, American Legion Auxiliary and P. T. A. all provide volunteer workers. Parents are visited, explanation given them on a personal basis, transportation provided if needed, and an intensive campaign is carried on to bring children to the conference.

The following brief summary is adequate evidence that the educational campaign is showing dramatic results. Medical

conferences are held for both white and colored children. In 1954 124 infants were examined by the doctors and health recommendations were made. 334 school children were examined. 471 children were given typhoid immunizations and 246 typhoid booster shots were given. 346 children were given diptheria, whooping cough and tetanus shots. 44 children were given gamma globulin shots. All the children old enough had dental and eve examinations.

Through the co-operative efforts of the doctors, nurses, newspapers, radio, health department and volunteers from assisting groups, the people in Newport are thoroughly conscious of the importance of its children's health, and are actively supporting the well-child conference program.

Welfare Program

The Service League has a clothing room for children on the second floor of the county courthouse where donated clothing is stored, mended and distributed. The Service League has clothing drives every year and asks that all good used outgrown clothing be given for these school children. George Rachel Ladd and Doris Rogers are chairmen of the welfare room and are always glad to call for clothing donations.

Since it is essential that children's shoes fit them, we purchase new shoes for the children, as well as other items of clothing needed which we do not have in room. So for this school year we have spent between \$450 and \$500 on needed clothing for 135 children which have been outfitted this year with at least two changes of clothing.

The school teachers through their principals refer the children in need of clothing to the clothing room chairman. A large number of the children clothed would not be able to attend school if it were not for this service. The effect of this aid on tendance, better adjusted children and school children is remarkable — better atbetter school work. The Service League and better school work. The League dresses their school children like the other boys and girls. It's important to the children.






